

White Wines

Marques de Calado Macabeo, Spain £15.00
(175ml £4.00 / 250ml £5.25)

Five Foot Track Chardonnay, Australia £17.00
(175ml £4.50 / 250ml £6.00)

Pale straw yellow with youthful green hues. A nose of citrus fruits and ripe apples, with underlying notes of vanilla. Crisp lemon and lime on the palate, served up with a rounded and buttery feel

Bantry Bay Chenin Blanc, S. Africa £19.00
(175ml £5.00 / 250ml £6.50)

An aromatic wine with hints of tropical and citrus fruit on the nose and palate

Vina Carrasco Sauvignon Blanc, Chile £20.00
(175ml £5.25 / 250ml £7.00)

Thoroughly citrusy on the nose, with fresh lime and lemon forming the aromatic backdrop. More citrus on the palate, accompanied by a ripe hint of pineapple, and mouth-watering acidity.

Pasqua Pinot Grigio, Italy £21.00
(175ml £5.50 / 250ml £7.50)

A fresh and fruity wine with lots of crunchy fruits, crisp, citrusy acidity and a well-balanced finish.

Fernlands Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, NZ £25.00

Very zesty on the palate with lots of lime and a nettle herbaceousness, this is an aromatic and classic New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc with a refreshing dry finish.

Petit Chablis UVC, Burgundy £28.00

A bright and approachable Chardonnay, with an absence of oak allowing the generous ripe apple and citrus fruit to shine through. Snappy acidity and a subtle mineral tinge provide a crisp finish.

Montagny 1^{er} Premier Cru, France £31.00

A delicious, fresh Chardonnay which has been fermented and matured in stainless steel tanks to preserve the pure peach, pear and acacia aromas. Soft and rich on the palate.

Sancerre Roger Neveu, Loire, France £35.00

Aromas of ripe rhubarb and gooseberry leap from the pale lemon coloured glass, along with hints of lime, chalk and flint, mineral texture, high acidity, vibrant green fruits and a long, lingering finish.

Viré-Clessé Cordier, Burgundy, France £40.00

Elegant yet opulent, this wine combines fresh fruit on the palate with a mineral core, with added dimension provided by a slight toastiness.

Red Wine

Marques de Calado Tempranillo, Spain £15.00

(175ml £4.00 / 250ml £5.25)

Flor Del Fuego Cabernet Sauvignon, Chile £20.00

(175ml £5.25 / 250ml £7.00)

A medium weight red, with a pleasing balance between ripe fruit and savoury, earthy notes on the nose.

Baron De Baussac Carignan, France £21.00

(175ml £5.50 / 250ml £7.50)

Deep and inky red in colour, the wine is crammed with black cherry fruit, lifted by subtle vanilla aromas from a touch of oak ageing.

Pavillon Trois Arches Merlot, France £22.00

(175ml £5.75 / 250ml £7.75)

Deep ruby red in colour with aromas of berries and sweet spice. The pallet is smooth and rich with a depth of flavour that continues in the mouth.

Five Foot Track Shiraz, Australia £23.00

(175ml £6.00 / 250ml £8.00)

The nose and palate exhibit lifted aromas of plum and spice with floral undertones whilst the finish is long and flavoursome. Cherry coloured medium bodied and dry.

Bantry Bay Pinotage, South Africa £24.00

(175ml £6.25 / 250ml £8.25)

Intense on the nose, with a bouquet of coffee, chocolate and cherry, with meaty, savoury hints. The tannins are ripe, perfectly suiting the round and mouth-filling plum and mulberry fruit.

Capilla De Barro Malbec, Argentina £25.00

(175ml £6.50 / 250ml £8.50)

An intense red-purple colour, with an equally intense nose of plum and bramble. Fulsome on the palate, delivering a swathe of ripe, fresh black fruit held together by lush tannins.

San Millan Rioja Crianza, Spain £26.00

(175ml £7.00 / 250ml £9.00)

Red cherry colour with violet hues. Aromas of ripe red fruits with a subtle floral bouquet and notes of cinnamon and clove.

Templiers, Chotes Du Rhone, France £28.00

Full of warm summer fruits and with a spicy finish. Mix of organic Grenache and Shiraz.

Fairhall Pinot Noir, Marlborough, NZ £32.00

Offers terrific value and delivers tremendous quality. Wonderful flavours of soft plums and raspberry, it has the depth and body to satisfy any pinot noir lover.

Chateauneuf-Du-Pape, Les Puits, France £43.00

Ruby coloured, the nose is spicy & full of sweet dried fruits. The palate is medium to full bodied with spicy, gamey flavours allied with prune, raspberry and leathery notes. The finish is warm and ripe.
